

ENTERPRISE INTERNET

(Rate "TEI")

Availability:

Enterprise Internet service is available by the request of the business owner or other authorized business representative, if one or more of the following criteria are applicable:

- The service location is duly licensed to undertake an individual trade, business or profession in the city, county or state where Internet or VoIP service is available by the utility.
- The service location is a single location that has multiple dwelling or business units that are served under a single billing account.
- Public or Private Ownership.
- Greater than twenty (20) employees.
- One (1) or more operating locations.
- Service Level Agreement may be required.
- Requires additional CPE to provision end-user services whether provided by TCLP or customer.
- Contract required.
- Installation requires site visit and quote.
- Requires more than one (1) static IP address.
- Generally exceeds Small Business Administration Revenue Size Standards as organized by NAIC.
- Baseline sustained bandwidth above 50Mbps calculated by measuring the average peak bandwidth usage, defined as the maximum bandwidth used in successive traffic samples taken over 45 minutes on two consecutive days in a month.
- This rate is not available for resale purposes.

Nature of Service:

Enterprise Internet is a fiber-based broadband data service leveraging Internet Protocol (IP) technology. Internet services are subject to network availability at the service address. Internet services are provisioned with upload and download speeds the same, subject to availability, network latency, overheads, splices, power outages and network or customer premise equipment conditions in addition to other possible factors.

COMMERCIAL VOICE

(Rate "TCV")

Availability:

Commercial voice service is available by the request of the business owner or other authorized business representative, if one or more of the following criteria are applicable:

- The service location is duly licensed to undertake a trade, business or profession in the city, county or state where Internet or VoIP service is available by the utility.
- Service location is currently serviced by a single electric meter.
- Service location is a commercial building with individual business units serviced by a single electric meter.
- Private ownership.
- Sole proprietor or partnership.
- Less than twenty (20) employees.
- Single Location.
- No Service Level Agreement (SLA) required.
- Requires only standard Business ONT.
- Requires only 1 static IP address.
- General alignment with Small Business Administration Revenue Size Standards as organized by NAIC.
- Service location must be subscribed to Internet service.
- This rate is not available for resale purposes.

Nature of Service:

Commercial voice service is a digital communications service where voice communication is converted to IP technology and commonly referred to as Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP). VoIP service is subject to network availability at the service address, network latency, overheads, splices, power outages and network or customer premise equipment conditions in addition to other possible factors. VoIP service requires the use of specific CPE as identified below.

All calls to destinations outside of the US contiguous 48 states, including International calls will be charged on a metered basis (per minute) according to the applicable rates. Billing increments applicable to metered calls is 6 seconds for United States calls, 60 seconds for calls to Mexico, and all other and International calls are billed in 6 second increments, after the initial 30 seconds.
